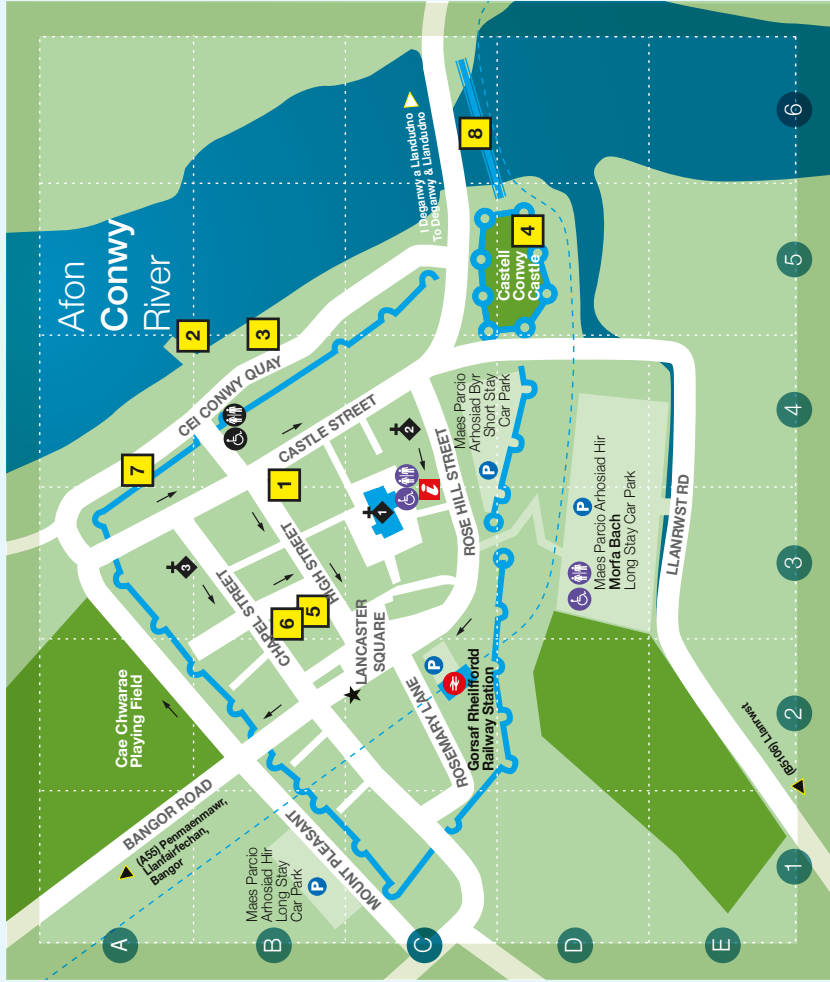

is just what it says - one ticket that gives you unlimited access to all of Wales's mainline train services and almost every bus service.

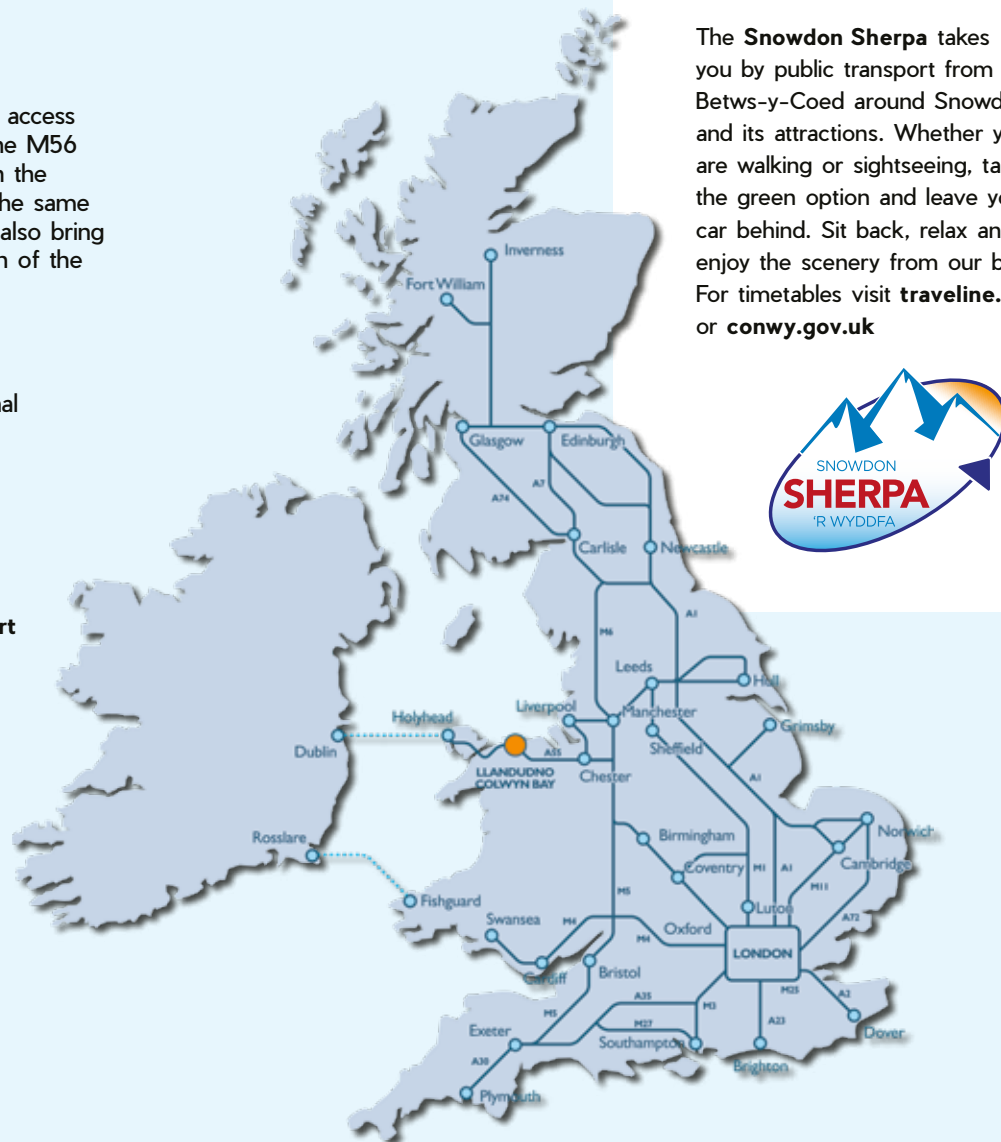
